ACADEMIC YEAR 2018 - 2019

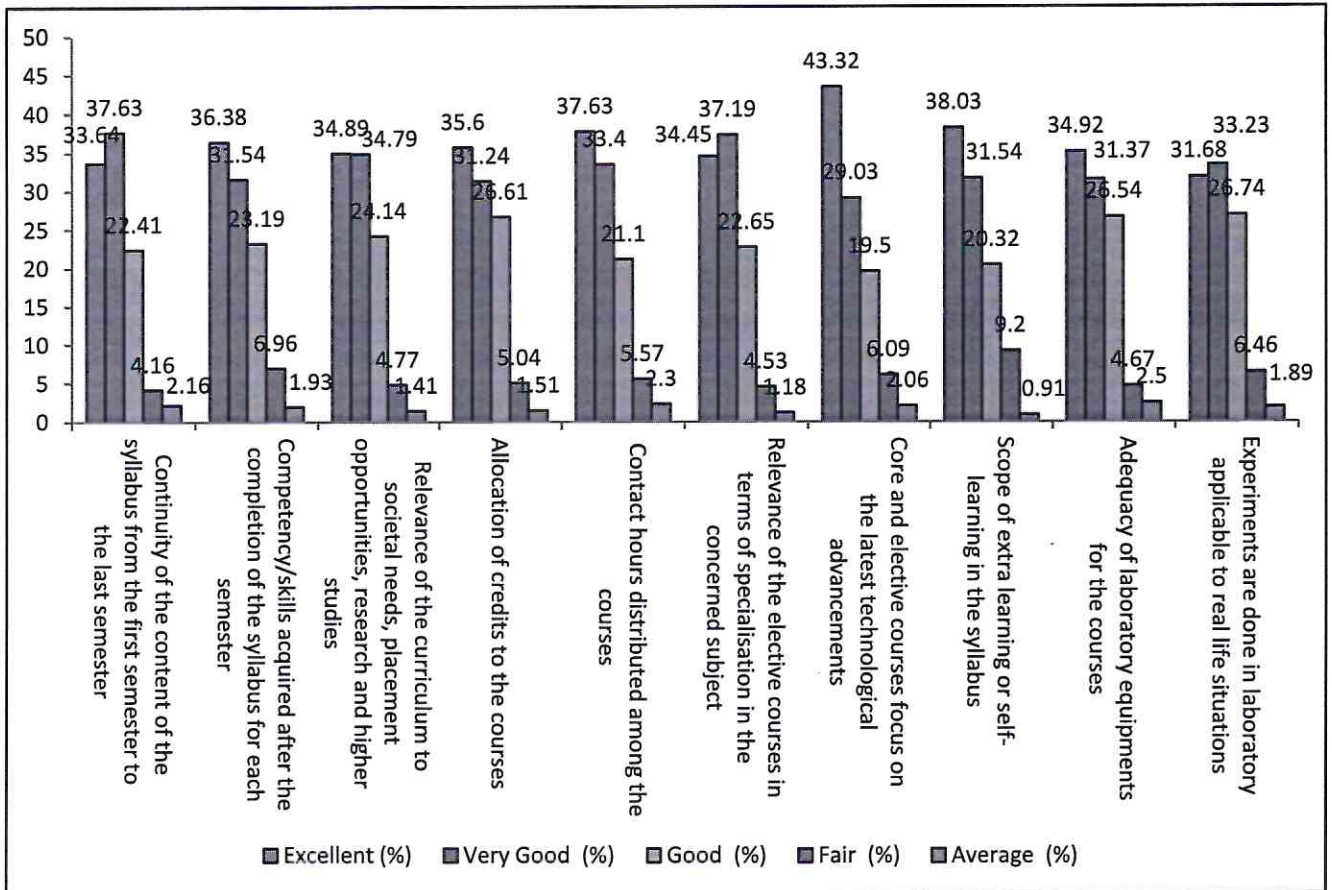
The Institution has a practice of collecting feedback on Curriculum from the stake holders every year to enrich the quality of the Curriculum. A structured feedback form on Curriculum with Five Point Scale is prepared and collected through online mode. The collected feedback is analysed by the Department. The analysed reports are scrutinized. Based on the feedback obtained the Curriculum is revised periodically catering to the needs of the students and demands of the other stakeholders.

II UG, III UG and II PG

Out of 2958 student respondents, the maximum of 43.32% opined that the core and elective courses focus on the latest technological advancements are excellent. 37.63% students agreed that the continuity of the content of the syllabus from the first semester to the last semester is very good. 26.74% and 26.61% expressed that experiments are done in laboratory applicable to the life situations and allocation of credits of the courses are good respectively.

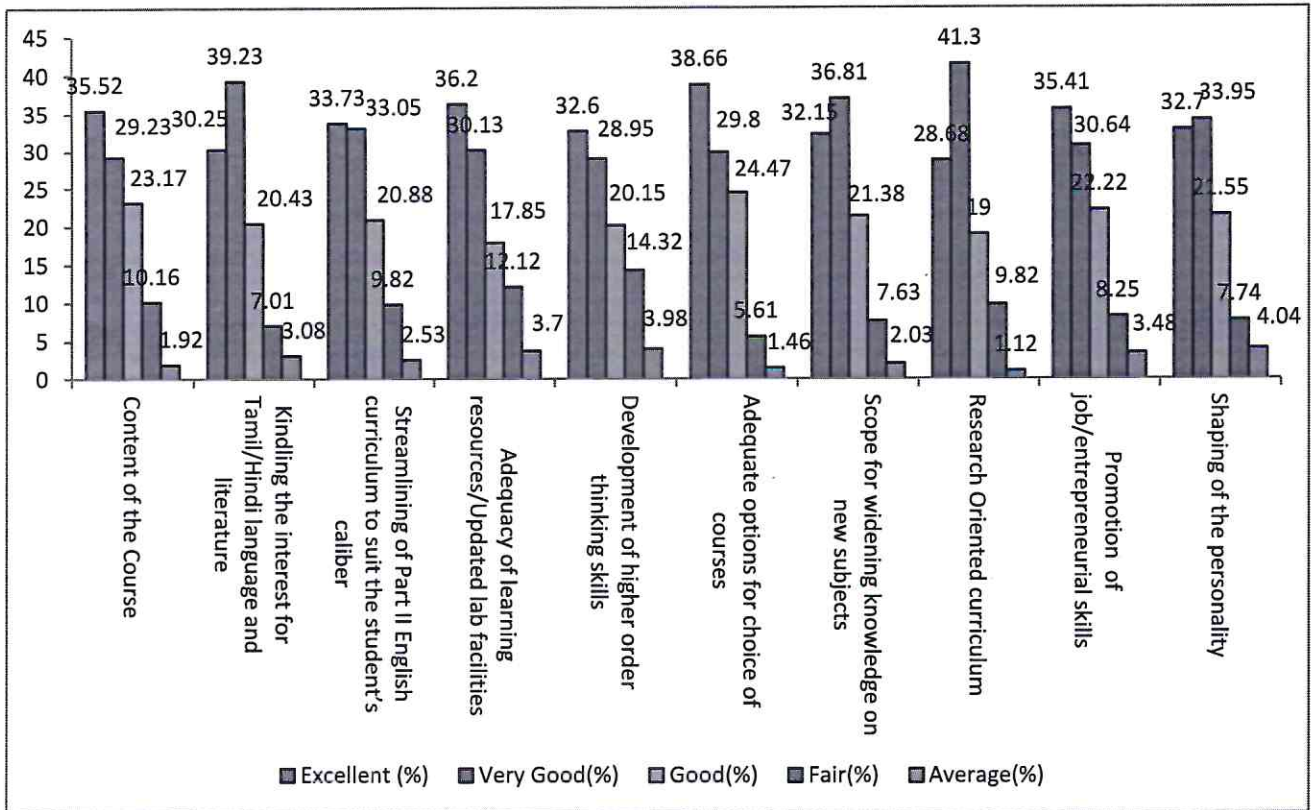
STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM (I UG AND I PG) ANALYSIS REPORT
