ANALYSIS REPORT ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 - 2021

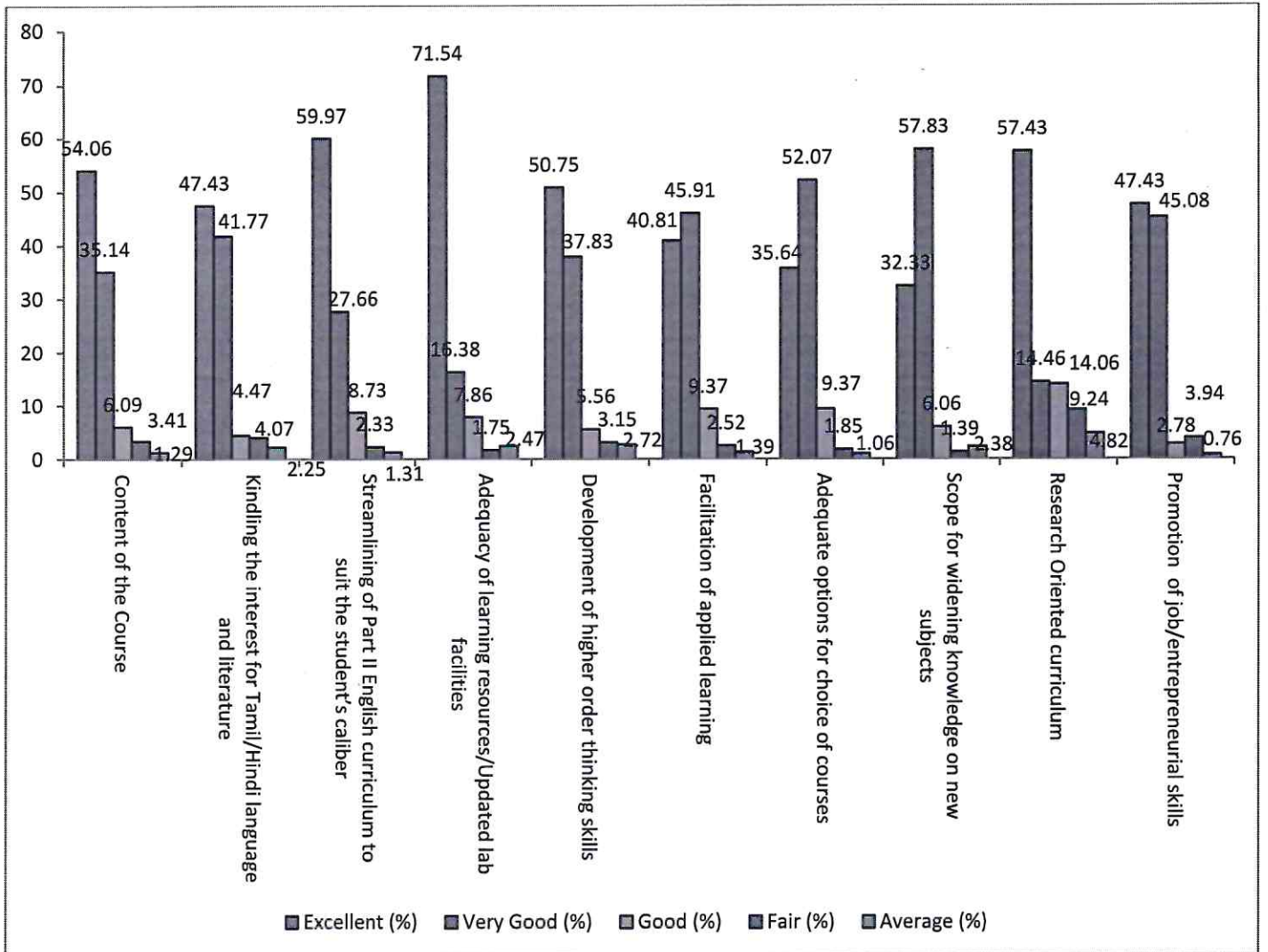

Out of 3019 student respondents, the maximum of 71.54% gave excellent opinion for the parameter 'Adequacy of learning resources/Updated lab facilities'. 57.83% students agreed that the scope for widening knowledge on new subjects is very good. 14.06% expressed that the research oriented curriculum is good.

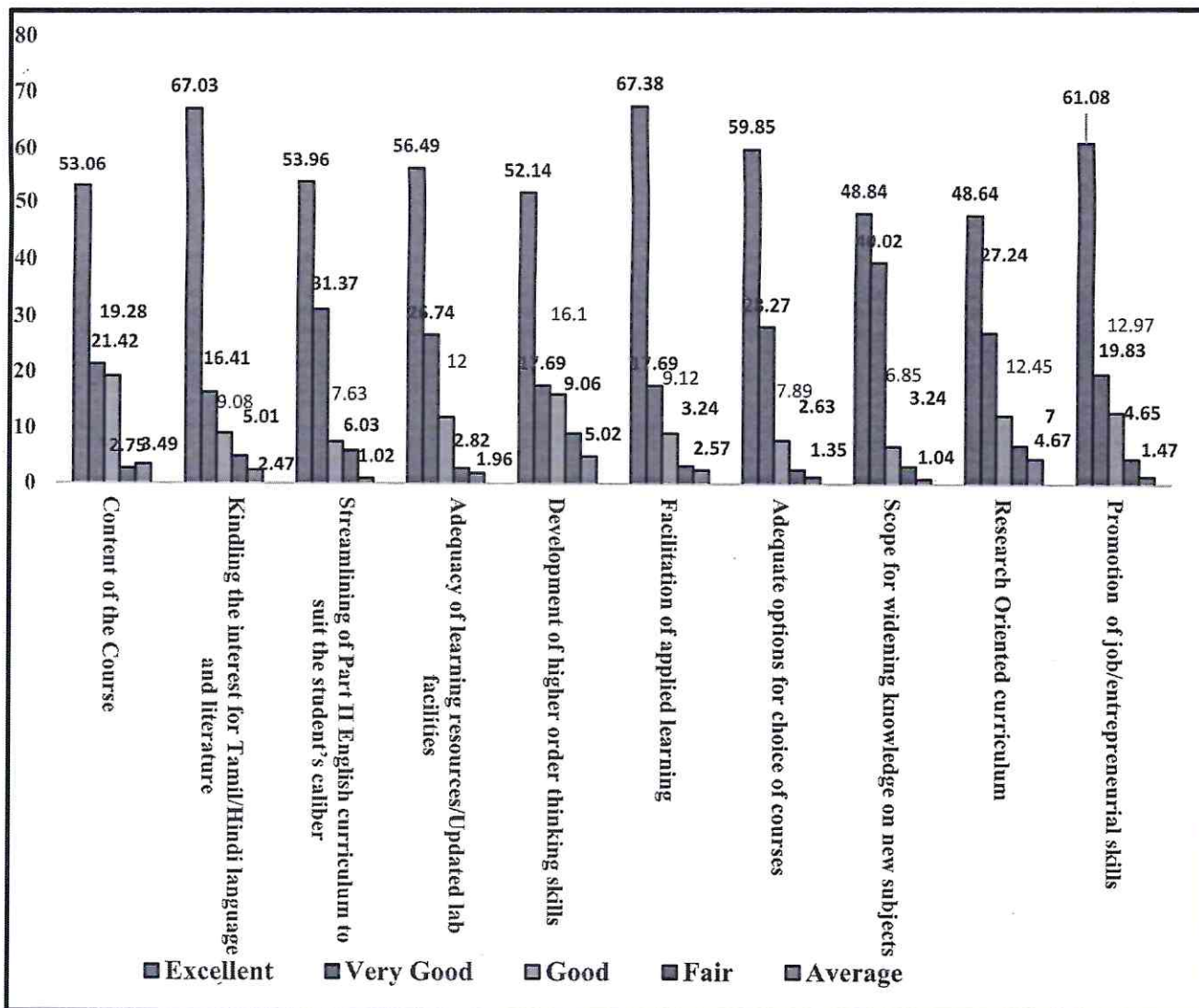
ANALYSIS REPORT ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 - 2021
