ANALYSIS REPORT

ACADEMIC YEAR 2023 - 2024

Totally 3643 students gave their feedback on Curriculum. The maximum of 57.02% respondents agreed that adequate options were provided to them to choose their interested Elective courses. 54.86% students stated that the focus on Skill Development in the Curriculum to enhance their employability and entrepreneurship was excellent. Around 52% of the respondents opined that the contents of the courses were relevant to Outcome Based Education and also stated that the Curriculum was research oriented. 50.39% of the students accepted that they were provided with adequate learning resources, and updated lab facilities. About 27% of the respondents felt that their interest for language and acquisition of grammatical knowledge and vocabulary to enhance the communication skill were very good. 22.59% had stated that scope for widening their knowledge on new subjects was good.

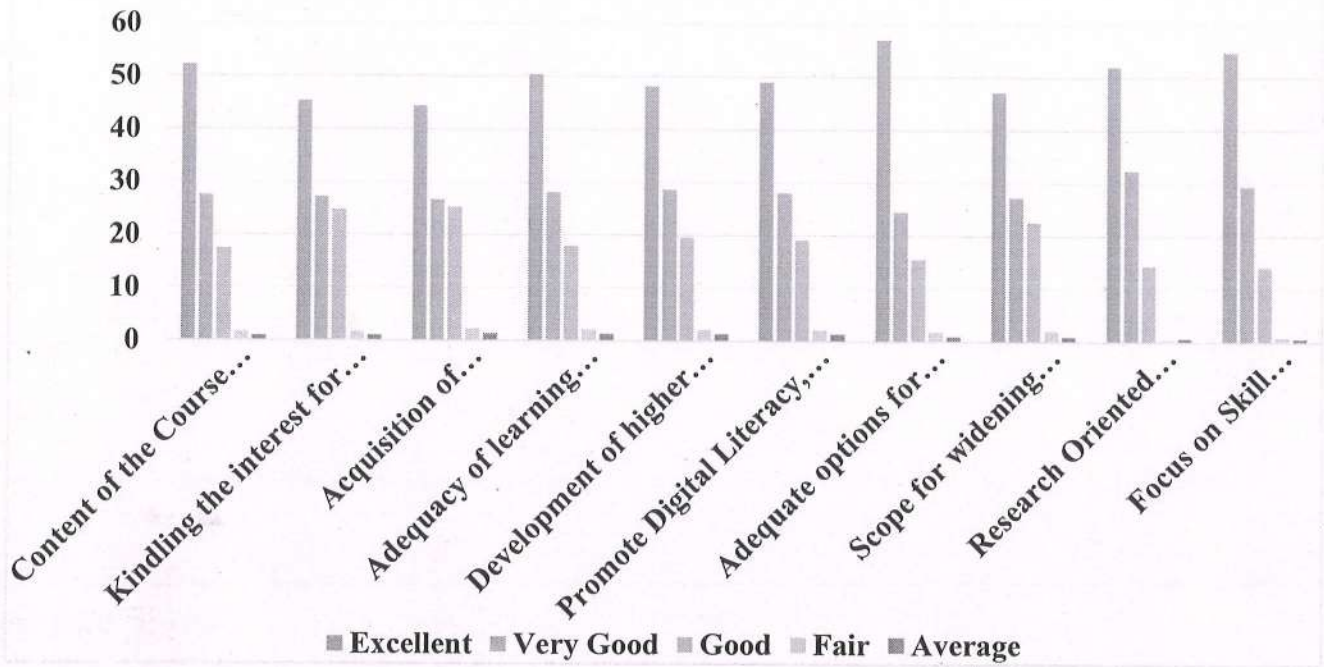
