FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

ACADEMIC YEAR 2024 - 2025

Every year feedback on curriculum was obtained from the students. In the academic year 2024-2025, 3667 students gave their feedback on curriculum. Among them, 54.3% stated that adequate options were provided to them to choose their interested Elective courses and 54.05% of the students accepted that the acquisition of Practical Experience / Technical skills were excellent. 52.05% agreed that the contents of the courses were excellently relevant to Outcome Based Education. 50.5% of the students agreed that the learning resources, and lab facilities were excellently updated. 50.45% students stated that the curriculum had been excellently framed to enhance the Digital Literacy, Self - directed and Lifelong Learning among the students. 50% agreed that the scope for insights into the courses was excellent. 49.95% of the respondents agreed that the focus on Skill Development in the curriculum to enhance their employability and entrepreneurship was excellent. About 48% of the respondents opined that the curriculum developed the higher order thinking skills. About 29% of the respondents felt that curriculum had enhanced their interest for language, acquisition of grammatical knowledge, vocabulary and communication skill.

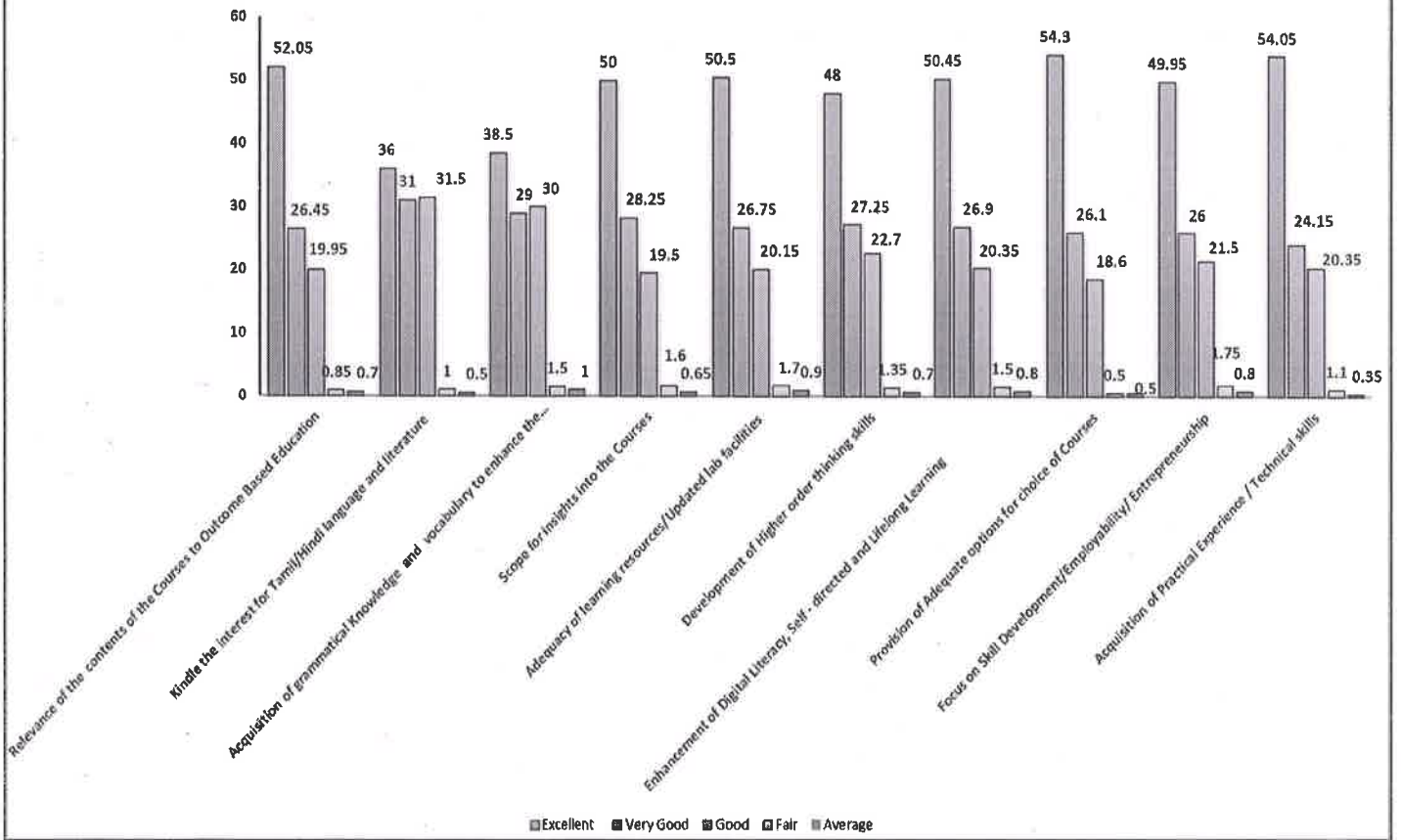
