On the basis of the report of the UGC Expert Committee and on the basis of the recommendations of the Standing Committee, the Commission at its meeting held on 27.07.2015 decided to grant extension of autonomous status to V.V. Vanniaperumal College for Women (Autonomous), (Belonging to Virudhunagar Hindu Nadars), Virudhunagar-626 001 (Tamilnadu) affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai under the UGC scheme for autonomous colleges for a period of six years w.e.f. 2015-2016 to 2020-2021.

29. Observations of the visiting committee

The committee found several positive features in the college. Some of them are recorded below:

- ☞ New India Accidental Scheme is available for all the employees of the college.
- ☞ Six months leave on full salary is provided to the teaching faculty for submitting Ph.D. Thesis.
- ☞ Library is well equipped, and digitalized. Librarian is competent. The college gives Best Library User Award to the students.
- ☞ Two credit courses on Value Education are being taught in sixth semester.
- ☞ Rain water harvesting system is in use.
- ☞ Energy Audit is conducted to minimize energy consumption.
- ☞ The college has received Best Women's College Award for Youth Welfare and Cultural activities consistently for five years.
- ☞ Special career guidance programmes are conducted to the students
- ☞ The Competence Development Cell conducts Personality Development Programmes and Placement cell conducts several programmes to enhance the employability skills of the students
- ☞ There are five hostels accommodating 1,656 students
- ☞ Fee concession, Free food and accommodation, other requisite facilities are provided to sports persons free of cost.
- ☞ Departments of Life Sciences have tie ups with research centres, hospitals and industries.
- ☞ Of late, the good number of faculty members have become research oriented. Currently, 59 faculty members are holding Ph.D. degrees out of 90 faculty members.
- ☞ 'Earn while you Learn Programme' is implemented for the benefit of the students
- ☞ Students conduct Nutrient content analysis of various products.
- ☞ Children of Staff are given fee concession

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30. Suggestions of the visiting committee

The visiting committee wishes to make the following suggestions for the further growth and development of the college.

- ☞ More facilities should be provided to Research scholars.
- ☞ Salary of the un-aided employees may be further raised.
- ☞ More language labs will help the students
- ☞ Use of more LCDs will increase the quality of teaching in academic departments
- ☞ Campus can be made Wifi enabled.
- ☞ College surroundings can be made more clean and debris be removed on priority
- ☞ Air conditioning of the seminar hall will be useful.
- ☞ There is an urgent need for air conditioning of atleast one Meeting hall to hold large meetings.
- ☞ The hostels should have three residents instead of five per room.
- ☞ The college buildings require fresh coat of painting.
- ☞ The college may start some programmes in Social Sciences particularly ⁱⁿ the areas of Economics, Political Science , Sociology and Psychology.
- ☞ The college must have a Centre for Women's studies sponsored by UGC.

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
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31. Recommendations of the visiting committee




