The software Students Database System has been installed for storing and retrieving the student information as and when needed in the required format. Bill Desk maintains the details of Admission fees, Examination fees and Hostel fees. The office of Controller of Examinations is equipped with VVVC Exam Master to automate the functionalities of the CoE office and to generate and print the Hall Tickets, Mark Statements and various analytical reports. Online Examination software is designed to conduct Online Objective type examination for the final year students as part of their curriculum and also to train the PG students to appear for SET/NET exams. The selection of NME Courses for both UG and PG are carried out with NME Selection Software. A specially designed Software DigiElection Soft is used to conduct the digital polling of students' Union Cabinet Election. The activities of library like Automation of Bibliographic Record, Report Generation Circulation, and Digitization of Institution Repository: College Hand Books, Magazines and Question Papers, Web OPAC, Remote Access are automated using freeware and implemented as Integrated Library Management System.

1.4.2 – How the feedback obtained is being analyzed and utilized for overall development of the institution? (maximum 500 words)

Feedback Obtained
<p>The institution has a practice of collecting feedback on curriculum from Students, Teachers (External examiners and the faculty members of the Board of Studies), Employers, Alumni and Parents through questionnaire. The analysis of the feedback is done systematically and the appropriate actions were taken based on the analysis and suggestion provided. Students' Feedback: Students' Feedback on curriculum revealed that the number of Conferences/ Seminars/ Workshops/ Guest Lectures were organized effectively to support the curricula. ICT Tools could be used for newly introduced courses to support the teaching</p>

and learning. More number of skill enhancement courses need to be introduced. Action Taken: The teachers resolved to use ICT tools to enhance their teaching. The outgoing students were encouraged to pursue online courses (Swayam - NPTEL). e - lectures were uploaded in the local server for the slow learners. The students were instructed to submit their Assignments, Quizzes and Seminars through Google Classrooms to develop various skills among the students. More number of skill enhancement courses were introduced and passed through Academic Council Meeting. Teachers' Feedback: External examiners and the Faculty members of the Board of Studies suggested that the courses and the contents were framed to satisfy the needs of the current scenario. The contents of the courses could provide more scope to test the technical and analytical skills of the students. More focus could be given to research attitude in the curriculum of PG courses. Action Taken: The contents of the Practical courses are slightly modified to acquire more practical knowledge of the theoretical concepts. A few courses were introduced to develop the Research ambience among the students. Alumnae Feedback: Feedback of the Alumni reported that a more practical approach could be adopted to enhance the quality of curriculum and insisted the need of introducing more courses in the curriculum to enhance Entrepreneur skills of the students. Action Taken: The curriculum has been framed in a way to use ICT that aids understanding theoretical concepts practically. New courses in each programme were introduced to develop Employability and Entrepreneurship skills of the students. Parents' Feedback: Parents' Feedback on curriculum stated that the curricula of all programmes were well structured. The content of the courses must focus more on employability skills and communication skills of the students. Syllabi could be designed to make students aware of the industrial environment. Action Taken: A few courses were introduced to promote Employability skills and Entrepreneurship skills among the students. To provide industrial exposure to the students, industrial visits, Internship courses and signing of MOUs were incorporated in the curriculum. Employers' Feedback: The feedback given by the employers on curriculum made clear that the curriculum should be effectively framed to induce the innovative thinking among students. Theory and practical courses should facilitate the students to use modern equipment and ICT Tools. Action Taken: To develop the innovative thinking of the students, Projects has been introduced in the curriculum. Some Practical courses were introduced with slight modifications to make the students acquire knowledge about the modern techniques.

Yes. Our college has a well organised Students Mentoring System that acts as an individualized form of counseling and guidance to students. The Mentoring System promises to foster a strong rapport between the students and teachers at a personal level. Each faculty member is a member of a group of 25 to 30 students and maintains a record for each mentee with her personal as well as academic particulars. The mentor meets the group informally outside the class hours at least twice a month and discusses matters freely via a two –way communication process. The students are encouraged to seek guidance on academic, general or psychological issues. In case of academic irregularities or negative behaviours, the parents of the concerned students are apprised personally and necessary remedial measures are taken. The mentor keeps track of the academic performance of the mentee by registering their periodic as well as semester exam marks on the basis of which students were counselled and encouraged to improve their performance. The mentor guides them to reach their aspired career goals as well. The Students Mentoring System plays an effective role to discuss, decipher and disentangle mentor's problems in a smooth manner.

4.4.2 – Procedures and policies for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc. (maximum 500 words) (information to be available in institutional Website)

The institution follows systematic procedures for maintaining and utilizing Physical, Academic and support facilities. Special initiatives are undertaken to improve the Physical ambience. In addition to regular recruitment, the college has employed additional persons to look after the maintenance and repair work of instruments, equipment and furniture as and when needed.

Library: The general library renders a user friendly service. It functions from 8.45 am to 5.15 pm on all working days and on Sundays from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm (except on holidays). Students are strictly forbidden from sub-lending library books. In case of any loss of a book, 3 times the cost of the book will be collected from the borrower of the book. The worn out rare books garnered from the general library and department libraries are given for binding annually.

Laboratories: Laboratories are equipped with sufficient number of required experimental setups. The Laboratory equipment and instruments are calibrated by the technical Laboratory Assistants under the supervision of the Teaching Faculty. Students are instructed to handle the equipment with care under the

supervision of staff and laboratory assistants. The availability of FIST Laboratories invigorates and amplifies the prevalence of scientific and technical ambience. Playground: Playground is properly utilized to conduct coaching and selection camps and organize intercollegiate tournaments and friendly matches. A gallery in the playground promotes the sportive interest of both the players and nonplayers. Recreational hall with indoor games are utilized by the inmates. Playground is well maintained and weeds are removed periodically with the help of the gardeners. The best sports goods are purchased in the beginning of every academic year. Damaged goods are auctioned regularly. Computers: Computers with Internet Browsing facility is provided to all departments to access Online teaching and learning resources. Computers in laboratories are used to conduct Online Examinations and Aptitude Tests. The institution has an Instrumentation Maintenance Facility Centre (IMF) with a technician who installs and maintains all computers, scanners and printers. Campus: Inspection of electrical work and renewal of transport license are processed systematically. To overcome the problem of electrical load shedding, High Tension (HT) transformer and generators have been installed in the college premises to provide uninterrupted power supply. Fire extinguishers have been kept for use in all Buildings, Laboratories, Offices and Library. In the seven Seminar Halls with LCD projector facility, the college organizes Seminars, Conferences and Intercollegiate competitions. To maintain pollution - free campus, Liquid and Solid wastes are segregated and disposed carefully. An eco friendly Sanitary Napkin Incinerator helps to destroy the napkins in hygienic way. RO plant, standby generator, canteen, ATM, Bank Extension Counter, DTP center, Gymnasium, Meditation Hall, Central store, Buses and Vans for conveyance, 24x7 Medical care, Parking area, Visitors' Hall and Security system are the other amenities available. The entire campus has been maintained clean and green and the existing buildings have been renovated and repaired periodically.
