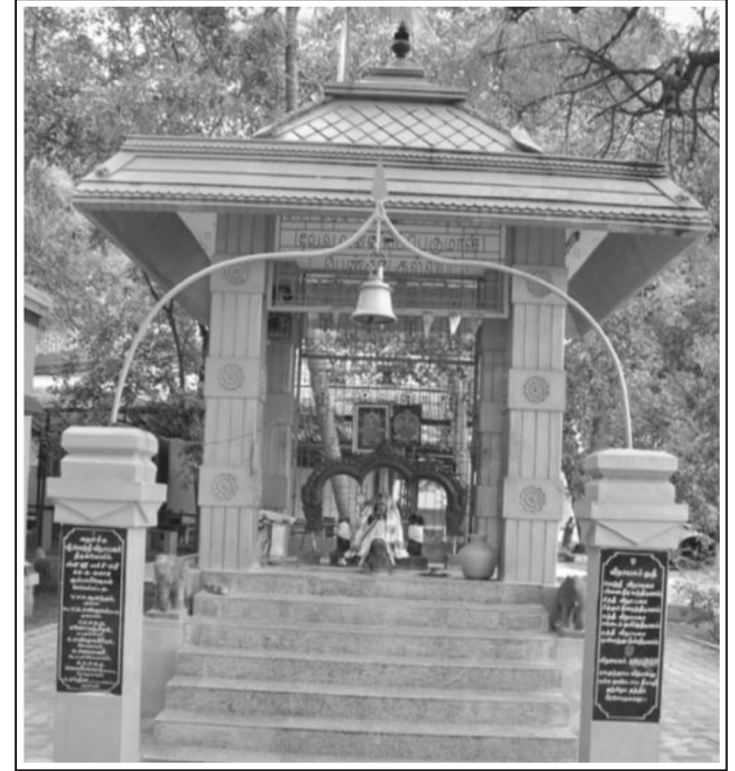

Brief History of the College

With the affiliation granted by the University of Madras for the Pre - University Course and with the approval granted by the Director of Public Instruction, Madras (Proc.Rc.No. 2253 ka/61 dt. 7-4-62) this college was started on 23.6.1962 by the V.H.N.S.N. College Paribalana Sabai, Virudhunagar. Then its name was "Virudhunagar Women's College". Later in recognition of the meritorious service rendered and the donation given by V.V.Vanniaperumal of Virudhunagar, the college was named "V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women" (Belonging to Virudhunagar Hindu Nadars), Virudhunagar. This change in name was approved by the University of Madras and the Director of Public Instruction, Madras (D. Dis. 741/63 dt. 1-2-63). It was under the V.H.N.S.N. College Paribalana Sabai till a separate managing board was formed and registered. The first managing board took charge on 26-8-66. The college became affiliated to the Madurai Kamaraj University in 1966. There are seventeen well facilitated blocks, a state-of-the-art multipurpose hall, Computer Labs, a well equipped digitized library, a spacious well furnished and adequately equipped administrative block and a vast playground. The Principal is the Warden of the hostels and she is assisted by the Deputy Warden and the Resident Tutors. Nearly 900 students reside in the hostels.

Because of the untiring efforts taken by the Managing Board new courses of study have been started every year since the time of inception of the college in 1962. At present there are nearly 3800 students in the college. The college functions from 9.30 a.m. to 3.30 p.m.

The Tamilnadu Higher Education Department introduced Choice Based Credit System uniformly in all the colleges throughout Tamilnadu since 2009-10. Higher education programmes have to be designed to meet the growing demands of specialization, to provide flexibility in the combination of courses to facilitate mobility among the courses, to update and modernize curricula to meet the demands of the job market. Under CBCS, 140 credits are a mandatory requirement for qualifying an Under Graduate Degree and 90 credits for a Post Graduate Degree.

The college is conferred with fresh autonomous status since 2009-2010. It is Reaccredited with prestigious 'A++' grade (4th cycle) by NAAC on 28-03-2024. The college has successfully completed 60 years of its service to the education sector and is steadily marching ahead towards achieving more excellence. To strengthen the teaching facilities in all science departments of the college, ₹ 50 lakhs has been sanctioned under FIST Program for five years. The college received a grant of ₹ 123 lakhs (Rupees one crore and twenty three lakhs only) from the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) Star College Scheme from 2020 to 2023 and significantly enhanced its infrastructure, upgraded laboratories with advanced equipment, supported innovative research projects and further enriched the teaching and learning environment of Departments including Life Sciences, Physical Sciences and Computer Science. The college has become an ISO 9001:2008 Certified Institution on 13.08.2014. The status of ISO 9001:2015 has been obtained on 24-12-2019.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FEE CONCESSIONS

Government Scholarships

P.G. Students belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes (including converts) are eligible for concession in tuition fees under 92 TNER if they produce community certificate.

Scholarship - Adi Dravida Welfare Department

Adi Dravida Welfare Scholarship is granted under Government of India and State Government Schemes. SC / ST students whose parents' annual income is below ₹ 2,50,000/- are eligible for the above scholarship. The SC / ST students whose parents' annual income is above ₹ 2,50,000/- are eligible for award of free education i.e., reimbursement of special fee, examination fee etc.,

Hostel students who have not applied under the above scheme and studying in U.G. Degree classes are also granted a sum of ₹ 7,500/- each as Higher Education Special Scholarship. P.G. Students are granted a sum of ₹ 8,000/-.

U.G. degree students who have joined the First Year of the programme are eligible for Chief Minister Award of ₹ 3,000/- each, if they obtain highest marks which are prescribed by the ADTWD.

Scholarship - Backward Class Welfare Department

All U.G. (Reg) students belonging to BC, MBC and DNC are eligible for award of free education i.e., Reimbursement of special fee, examination fee etc.,

Residential Scholarship is sanctioned by the B.C.W Dept. to the U.G. and P.G. (Reg) students belonging to BC, MBC and DNC, if their parents' annual income does not exceed ₹ 2,00,000/-. Since the scholarship amount is disbursed through ECS by Welfare Departments, the students should open an account in Nationalised Bank.

Children of Ceylon and Burma Repatriates

Financial assistance and concession are granted to students who are the children of Ceylon and Burma repatriates on submission of necessary certificate.

Pudhumai Penn Scheme

The scholarship applies to the girl students of Tamilnadu who are studied in Govt. and Govt aided Schools, (Tamilmedium) from 6th standard to 12th standard are granted a sum of Rs.1000/-per month.

Students's Aid Fund

Monetary help is given to students from Student's Aid Fund. Students who are not getting any other scholarship alone are eligible for this aid. Selection will be on the basis of merit, parent's annual income and in accordance with the rules of committee.

National Scholarship for Post-Graduate Studies

In order to achieve and promote girl's education, UGC has introduced a Post-Graduate Scholarship for Single Girl Child and all the girl child with an aim to compensate direct costs of girl education to all levels especially for such girls who happen to be the only girl child in their family.

Post Matric Scholarship Scheme

The main aim of this scheme is to provide opportunities of higher education to weaker section of Minority Communication in view of enhancing their employability rate. The Students pursuing graduation, Post-graduation, M.Phil. or Ph.D. who have scored at least 50% marks or equivalent in the previous exam and whose annual income of the family does not exceed ₹ 2,00,000/- are eligible to apply.

Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students (PM-USP CSSS)

This scholarship is awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. It is provided as financial assistance to the meritorious students from poor families to meet apart of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies.

Non - Government Scholarships

Retired Teachers Fund

As the crowning achievement of our Golden Jubilee Celebrations, our retired Principals and all our retired faculty are generous enough to institute the fund of ₹ 2,06,000/- entitled "V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women Retired Teachers Kamadhenu Golden Jubilee Fund" to help the economically disadvantaged students of Self-Financing Courses.

Gurushisya

The Teaching faculty of both Aided and Self-Financing programmes contribute liberally to the Guru-Sishya Fund either on monthly basis or annually for the cause of financially weaker section of students in the college.

Provision is also made for online submission of grievances in the Student Corner of the College Website to register any grievance and book slot for personal counseling. The information regarding the complaints is maintained as strictly confidential. This Cell paves the way for redressing the grievances of the students received to develop in them a proper perspective of life.

Internal Complaints Committee

Internal Complaints Committee paves way for the effective enforcement of basic human rights and assures an environment free of harassment and abuses enabling all the members of the Institution to experience congenial working and learning atmosphere.

The Committee scrutinizes the complaints represented by the students periodically and addresses them duly for rectification.

SC / ST Cell

The SC / ST Cell is re-constituted for the academic year 2023 - 2024, to implement, monitor and evaluate continuously the reservation policy of State / Central Government and guide the students to utilise the benefits of the schemes offered by the Government.

Anti-Ragging Cell

The University Grants Commission emphasizes the Higher Education Institutions to ban Ragging inside the College Campus. Anti-Ragging Committee of V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women, Virudhunagar sensitizes the students periodically against Ragging through various Awareness Programmes and Activities to make the Campus Ragging Free and provide conducive learning atmosphere. This Cell makes the students submit online Anti-Ragging Affidavit with the consent of their parents. It also takes care of printing the details of Toll Free Number and the Anti-Ragging website at the backside of the Students' Identity Card. Anti-Ragging Squad comprising of three Senior Faculty of the Institution is vigilant at all hours and submit recommendations to the Committee whenever needed.

Anti-Drug Club

Anti-Drug Club of V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women, Virudhunagar aims to create an awareness about the ill effects of drug usage among the younger generation. The club strives to ban on the possession and consumption of drugs and alcohol. It also educates the students against drug abuse, drug addiction, alcohol addiction and its ill effects. The Club organizes various awareness programmes, conducts competitions and make students take pledge. Anti-Drug Club adopts the precautionary measures for the prohibition of drug abuse in the college.

Student Welfare Committee

Student Welfare Committee of the Institution acts as a link among the Students, Teaching Faculty, Non-Teaching Faculty and Administration. One out going Student from each Programme and the College Students Union Cabinet Members partake in the Meetings conducted periodically along with the Dean-Student Endeavours, Principal and the Administration. The committee deals with the issues, suggestions, recommendations of academic and non - academic matters of the student represented by its members. This committee pacify all the members of the Institution towards a wholesome development of the Students.

Department Student Council

At the end of every semester with the Head of Department as the Chairman and Members of Staff, Student Representatives and External Expert from some other Department as Members, this cell functions quiet efficiently to discuss about Curriculum, Teaching - Learning & Evaluation and other activities of the department. The feedback of the members will be reported by the External Expert to the Principal and the Members of the Board for further development of the department.

SUPPORT AND SERVICE FORUMS / CELLS / CLUBS

College Union and Affiliated Associations

The College Union is the main organization of the student's body of the college. The Principal is the Ex-Officio President of the Union. Six senior members of the teaching faculty nominated by the Principal are Vice Presidents of the Union. The student's office-bearers of the College Union are selected by all students at the beginning of the academic year by conducting Union online election. The office-bearers hold office for one academic year. Various service forums, support forums and association function under the College Union.

The College Union arranges meetings addressed by eminent scholars, organizes cultural programmes and conducts competition and debates for the benefit of the students. All its activities aim to enhance the student's personality by promoting the leadership qualities in them.

Youth Welfare Organization

This organization functions in accordance with guidance prescribed by the Department of Youth Welfare, Madurai Kamaraj University. The Principal is the President of the organization. Three members of staff are appointed as student service officers. The officers in consultation with the President appoint the staff - in

charge of various units functioning under this organization. The activities of the various units bring out the inherent talents in students and develop their personality.

Student-Faculty Research Forum

Student Faculty Research Forum provides a platform to promote research activities among the students and members of the staff.

Tutor-Ward System

Psychological care is provided to student of our college by adopting ward system. Values of life are imparted to the mentees by means of tutorial system. The Principal is the Chairman assisted by two members of the staff. Each mentor is assigned to a batch of mentees whose progress is assessed regularly and problems, if any, are solved promptly.

Planning Forum

The Principal is the President of the Planning Forum. A staff member from the Commerce Department is the Vice-President and she is assisted by a team of staff members. The Secretary and the Joint Secretary of the forum are selected from the final year students.

The main aim of the forum is to make the students and the people around as plan-conscious. It encourages students and the public to save money and popularize Government Schemes and create awareness through audio visual aids and lectures. It helps the students to get their permanent driving license, passport and Voter's ID.

Students Counselling Forum

Student Counselling Forum provides a platform for the students to promote the well-being of the Students in all aspects. It develops the personality of the Students by reviving in them a potential towards self-esteem, self-awareness, self-confidence and self-progress by clearly addressing and rectifying their personal, academic, social, psychological, health and financial issues. This forum organizes awareness programmes and conducts counselling confidentially for the needy.

Each Department gives counselling to the students at times of need, record the details and collects feedback from the students through the prescribed format.

Placement & Career Guidance Cell

The Principal is the chair person and the functioning of the cell is co-ordinated by a Director (Placement) assisted by a panel of teachers. The placement cell functions effectively with a full time

Placement Officer. This cell is keen on exposing our students to job opportunities available through various Job Fairs conducted at our college and other places by leading companies. The outgoing students are well trained in mental ability, interview techniques, soft skills and communication skills to make them employable graduates.

Women Empowerment Cell

The purpose of women's education is to liberate and elevate them economically for which they must be empowered with job-oriented skills. The academic courses need to be complemented by self-supportive courses. The Women Empowerment Cell takes care of this with a zeal to make the students stand on their own legs. The Cell functions quite efficaciously with the Principal as the Chairman and two members of the staff as co-ordinators.

Uno-animo Club

Unanimo Club functions actively through out the academic year to create communal harmony awareness among the students and society at large.

Eco Club

Eco Club plays an important role in creating environmental awareness amongst the future generation. It also enables the students to be sensitive towards environmental problems.

Green Club

The main objectives of the Green Club are to make the college campus green by planting more saplings and also to recycle the bio waste.

Life Style Club

Life Style Club has the objectives to create awareness to students about dynamically progressing in their marital and professional life. It enunciates life's values among students. Further, it promotes affection, integrity, empathy, respect for the elders, social responsibility, discipline among the students.

Earn While you Learn

The aim is to provide opportunities for the needy and the deserving students to earn while they learn. It helps them to grow self-reliant.

Study Circle

The study circle of our college provides opportunities for the students to enhance their knowledge and skills required to crack various competitive examinations TNPSC, Bank Examinations.

House System

Our college's house system operates effectively through four dynamic houses : Sahana (Pink), Ranjani (Green), Sindhu (Blue) and Kalyani (Yellow). All students are assigned to one of these houses, each led by a staff co-ordinator and student representatives including a President, Vice President, Sports Captain and Sports Vice Captain. Students from these houses compete in academic, sports and cultural activities at the intra - collegiate level, with the top-performing houses receiving recognition at the end of the academic year.

Physical Education

Physical Education is meaningful and worthwhile experience obtained through participation in activities that are physically wholesome, mentally stimulating and socially sound. The aim of physical education is to provide facilities and opportunities of participation in physical activities through which the fullest development of man is attained.

National Service Scheme

The National Service Scheme is a special programme for the youth sponsored by the Government of India. This scheme was introduced in our college in August 1973. Four units, 183, 184, 223 and 233 are functioning in our college.

The Principal is the Chairman. Faculty members appointed by the Chairman are the Programme Officers. Each unit has one hundred students from the first and the second year degree classes. A Volunteer is required to put in 120 hours of work per year. The students who serve through these units for two years are eligible to get a certificate from Madurai Kamaraj University. An Advisory Committee consisting of the Chairman, the Programme Officers, members of the staff from various discipline and two student representatives is formed every year.

The NSS provides an opportunity to the students to work for the underprivileged section. NSS special camp is conducted at the adopted villages for 7 days. Awareness programmes like tree plantation, medical camp, blood group identification camp and cultural programmes are conducted during the camp.

It helps them to use their energy and knowledge to mitigate atleast some of the social problems. It involves students in constructive work and makes them serve the nation.

National Cadet Corps

The National Cadet Corps is the youth wing of Armed forces which is open to School and College students on voluntary basis. The Scheme helps the students in grooming discipline and patriotism. The cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The trained cadets, if selected will be attending the Republic Day Parade taking place every year in New Delhi.

Youth Red Cross

Service minded students, prepared for any kind of voluntary service are the members of this forum. The aim is to lend a helping hand to the needy people.

Red Ribbon Club

Red Ribbon Club is a movement started by the Government of India in Schools and Colleges through which students will spread awareness over HIV/AIDS. It envisages to instill charity mind among all the students to extend their able help towards developing healthy lifestyles, donating blood to all the needy by promotion of regular voluntary blood donation.

Social Service League

The Social Service league of the college functions with the Principal as the Patron and a staff member as the President. The Secretary is selected from the third year degree class.

This league trains the students to render service to the less fortunate brethren.

Rotaract Club

This forum is to provide an opportunity for the students to enhance the knowledge and skills in personal development, to address physical and social needs of their communities, to emphasize respect for the rights of others and to promote better relationship worldwide.

Extension Service Forum

The aim of higher education is to take the light of knowledge to the society at large. To implement this, we have constituted the Extension Service Centre with the Principal as the Chairman and two faculty members as the Co-ordinators. The objectives are to develop scientific thinking among rural school children, to impart job-oriented skills to rural womenfolk and to popularise Government schemes and to inculcate healthy practices in them.

Consumer Forum

The Consumer forum is started by District Forum in colleges through which students will make aware of consumer rights and create awareness among the people in villages.

LEARNER SUPPORT CENTRE (LSC)

Our college is a registered learner support centre for DDE Madurai Kamaraj University. The students of our college shall simultaneously enroll into one additional Degree or Diploma programme offered by the Directorate of Distance Education, Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai. It serves as a centre of learning for female aspirants who are either professionals or homemakers by providing them with an opportunity to engage in higher studies

ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION

There is an alumnae association which is registered as "V.V.Vannaperumal Pengal Kalloori Pazhaiya Maanaviyar Sangam" (Regn. No. 178/2017) in the academic year 2017-18. Alumnae Day is celebrated every year on last Saturday of December. From the alumnae association fund, nearly ₹16,000/- is distributed to the needy students every year.

4. The college buses ply between the town and the college and also in and around the town for the convenience of the staff and the students.
5. The railways offer concession for bonafide students of colleges to travel their home town during vacations. Students who intend to avail this concession should get their forms signed by the Principal on or before the last working day of the semester.
6. Browsing at concessional rate and xeroxing facilities are available.
7. A Reverse Osmosis Plant adds to the health of students.

GENERAL LIBRARY RULES

The General library of the College possesses about 67,315 books, 88 journals, magazines and e-resources including 7 Tamil Newspapers, 5 English Newspapers and 6 e-resources Institutional member in NDLI and Bookshare.org. The Librarian is in charge of Library.

- * All students, staff and clerical staff of the college are entitled to use the library.
- * The library is kept open on all working days from 8.30 a.m. to 5.25 p.m. and on Sundays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- * Strict silence should be observed in the library.
- * Students are provided with an e-card through which UG Students can borrow four books and four back volumes. PG Students can borrow six books and four back volumes. For quick and accurate circulation, the bar coding system is being followed. The students will be responsible for the books borrowed by them. web OPAC (web Online Public Access Catalog) should be used for the bibliographic details. Open Access system is followed. Students should not carry any book or printed matter into the library. For students, books will be issued from 11.30 a.m. to 11.45 a.m., 12.40 p.m. to 1.30 p.m. and 3.35 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.
- * Students are strictly forbidden from sub-lending library books. Students will be entitled to keep a book for fifteen days from the date of issue. At the end of the period, the book should be returned to the library.

- * A student failing to return a book after fifteen days from the date of issue has to pay a fine of Re.1/- for each day of delay for every book. In case of any loss of a book, 3 times of the cost of the book will be collected at the college counter.

DEPARTMENT LIBRARY RULES

The Head of the Department is in charge of books in the Department Library. An issue register is maintained in each Department Library. With regard to the loss or damage to the book in the Department Library, the rules of the General Library are followed.

LABORATORY RULES

Students should do only the specified experiments given in the cycle. Students should handle the apparatus with care. The interference of a student in other's work is prohibited. Strict silence must be observed in the laboratory. Students breaking or damaging any article or apparatus will be asked to replace it or pay the cost. Any difficulty felt during the practical work should be brought immediately to the notice of the lecturer. The Bonafide Certificate for practical work required by the University regulation will not be granted unless the performance and progress of a student in the laboratory are satisfactory.

CONVOCATION AND EXAMINATION RULES

Attendance

- 1) The students who have attended the classes for 85% and above are permitted to appear for the Summative Examinations without any condition.
- 2) The students who have 78% of attendance and above - up to 84% are permitted to appear for the Summative Examinations on payment of fine.
- 3) The students who have 66% of attendance and above - upto 77% can appear for the summative examinations only after getting special permission from the Principal. Special permission can be got from the Principal on medical grounds on payment of fine along with the application form for exemption. If permission is not granted, they have to appear for the Summative Examinations in the next semester on payment of fine.
- 4) The Students who have less than 65% of attendance cannot appear for the Summative Examinations and have to repeat the whole semester.

- 5) These rules are applicable to all UG and PG Programmes and come into effect from 2018-2019 onwards.
- 6) For Part V, the students require 75% of attendance to get a credit.
- 7) For Certificate, Diploma, Advanced Diploma and PGDCA Programmes, the students require 75% of attendance to appear for the Theory / Practical Examinations.

Examination

At the end of the semester, students appear for summative examinations.

1. Hall tickets, time tables and instructions for summative examinations are received from the Principal two or three days before the commencement of the examination.
2. Hall tickets of the students who owe money to the college or the hostel by way of fee, mess charges, disciplinary fine, library dues, laboratory breakage charge etc., shall be withheld until such dues are cleared.
3. The Statement of marks and grades will be issued to the students at an early date.

Convocation

The Diplomas of the passed out students will be sent to the college by the University during the course of the academic year. The college arranges for the Annual Convocation Day and on that occasion, diplomas are presented to them.

TO BE NOTED

The students who apply for leave should submit a leave letter in the proper format on or before the day she applies for leave. Late submission of the leave letter is not permitted. The student who fine to submit the leave letter has to pay fine each day, in case the fine is not paid, the Hall ticket for the ensuing summative examination shall be withheld.

The above mentioned rules and regulations will be implemented for the students from 21.06.2018. The students can access the college website for details regarding the date of examinations and results for supplementary examinations and arrear examinations, after publication of the results of the summative examinations.

After the publication of the results of the final semester examinations a supplementary examination will be conducted within one month for the students having arrear papers not exceeding three.
