ABOUT THE COLLEGE

V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women, a temple of learning founded by a great visionary Shri V.V.Vanniaperumal Nadar with a singular objective of empowering rural women through higher education, is a saga of human excellence, endurance and commitment for six decades. Having started with a meagre strength in 1962, the institution has grown by leaps and bounds into one of the reputed women's colleges in Tamilnadu. The strength has reached 4259 students of which 2052 are admitted in aided programmes and 2207 are admitted in self-finance programmes. The college offers 20 UG programmes, 14 PG programmes, 6 M.Phil. programmes and 5 Ph.D. programmes. 
Hence realizing the significance of imparting professional ethics, this programme is organized for the teaching faculty members.


