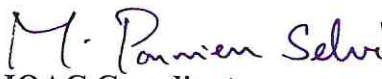

Resolution	Action Taken
Resolution 1 : ➤ To display the helpline numbers and website addresses at all important places inside the campus.	To implement the resolution, helpline numbers and website addresses are being prominently displayed from September 2024 onwards, at all important locations inside the campus, including: • Entrances and exits • Administrative offices • Notice boards in academic blocks • Hostels and canteens • Library and common areas
➤ To organize a faculty Sensitisation Programme on Student Welfare.	As part of the initiative a Faculty Sensitisation Programme on Student Welfare was conducted on 09.09.2024 for 175 Faculty members at Jegathambal Rajendran Meeting Hall. Dr.S.Cinthana, Principal addressed key aspects of student development and welfare.
➤ To organize an awareness programme educating all the students about Prevention of Sexual Harassment and drug abuse. The resource person must be legal experts, police officers and district Social Welfare Officers.	An Orientation Programme on Drug Awareness was organized by the Anti-Drug Club on 03.10.2024, featuring Dr. M. Sampathkumar, a Retired Professor and Fracture and Dermatology Specialist from Madurai Medical College, as the resource person. The session was attended by 243 students from NSS, NCC, YRC, and RRC units. As per the resolution to organize an awareness programme on the prevention of sexual harassment and drug abuse, the Internal Complaints Committee conducted a Sensitisation Programme on Sexual Harassment and Cybercrime on 12.09.2024 at the O.M.S.S.S. Raja Manicka Nadar-O.M.S.R. Ganesan Multipurpose Hall with 3755 student participants.
