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

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

INFERENCE

Course content of the programme:

It is inferred that out of 459 alumnae students 56% of the students felt that the course content of all the programmes was excellent. Only one of the alumni felt that it was fair.

Prospects to pursue Higher Studies/promote Research Caliber:

Among 459 alumnae students, 42.9 % of the students felt that the scope to pursue higher studies and research in the curriculum was excellent. Only 2 old students felt that it was fair.

Scope for Employment Opportunities and Entrepreneurship:

41.8 % of the alumnae students inferred that, there was a greater scope for employment opportunities and entrepreneurship. Only 3 of the students inferred that it was fair.

Opportunities to develop Communication Skills and Soft Skills:


It was noted that, 39.2% of the alumnae felt that the curriculum provides greater opportunities to develop communication and soft skills.
