Triumph of the College

Staff and Students

Our College created a significant niche in the annals of Higher Education ever since its inception in 1962.

- Our College has been progressing with its noble service in imparting quality education to rural women for sixty years. There are 2216 students in the Regular stream and 2445 Students in the Self-finance stream.

- In the Aided Stream there are 96 Teaching Staff and 34 Non-Teaching Staff. In the Self Finance Stream there are 135 Teaching Faculty and 148 Non-Teaching Faculty.

Courses Offered

- Our College offers 26 U.G.Courses, 14 P.G. Courses, 6 M.Phil. Courses, Ph.D. Programmes in English, Commerce, History and Mathematics, 6 Certificate Courses, 6 Diploma Courses, 2 Advanced Diploma Courses and 1 PGDCA course.

Highlights of the Management

- Smart Boards and LCD Projectors were provided to the Department of Costume Design and Fashion, and Department of Commerce(self)
- A Computer Centre with a Recreation Hall was constructed exclusively for the Hostel students.
- A new Dining Hall was built in the hostel.Two Dining Halls were linked using powder coated Roofing sheets.
- Eight new classrooms (4 class rooms in the ground floor and 4 class rooms in the first floor) were built in Theivathiru. Tmty.A.A.M.C.Nalina, Theivathiru(Selvi). A.A.M.C.Kasimalar Memorial Building.
- Two new Two-wheeler Parking sheds were constructed for the teaching and non-teaching faculty to ensure the hassle – free parking.
- Installation of False Ceiling and fitting of modernistic electric bulbs has been completed in the Jegathambal –Rajendren Meeting Hall, located on the first floor of T.K.S.P Arunachala Nadar – Bhuvanewari Ammal Administration Building
- False Ceiling was fixed for the Jegathambal –Rajendren Meeting Hall, located in the Idhayam Rajendren Library Building.
- Installation of False Ceiling and Modern Electric bulbs was done for the O.M.S.S.R.Rajamanika Nadar – Raja Soundariammal auditorium in the Multipurpose Hall.
- Rainwater conveyance path was constructed and linked to the well to store the runoff water.
- 200 feet concrete fence, located on the south part of the college, was revamped.
- The depth of the well was extended to 40 feet deep to augment the storage capacity of the well.
- College Managing Board sponsored Rs 1,00,000/- to ten selected Minor Research Projects.

- College Managing Board honoured the students and the staff members, who brought laurels to our college by their achievements and accomplishments, with mementos and prizes.
- A Two Week Outreach Programme for PG Assistants in Virudhunagar District under DBT Star College Scheme was organized from 15.12.2020 to 28.12.2020. College Managing Board is magnanimous to spare the hospitality expenditure of the Programme and it was not spent from the sanctioned amount of the DBT Star College Scheme.
- During the pandemic period, various technological facilities were done by the College Managing Board to facilitate the smooth functioning of online classes.
- College Managing Board was awarded with an honorary certificate for its commendable service and social responsibility by offering the institution for handling the Covid -19 pandemic.

Financial Assistance to students

Our College provides financial assistance to the needy students as a part of Student Welfare Activity Programme. Various charity agencies have come forward to render the helping hand.

- From Students Aid Fund, total sum of Rs.7,200 was given to 18 students.
- On behalf of Palasaraku Mahamai, a total amount of Rs.30,600 was given to 18 UG students and Rs.11,000 for 5 PG students.
- Chennai Foundation offered Rs.9909 for a B.Com. student and Rs.11,610 for a Microbiology student.
- Agram Foundation was magnanimous enough to give Rs.17,500 to two UG students. (Rs.10,000 to one student and Rs.7,500 to another student)
- Old Student Association contributed Rs.10,000 for the welfare of the students.

- V.V.Vanniaperumal College for woman Retired Teachers' Kamadhenu Golden Jubilee Fund has provided a total amount of Rs.1,17,500 as scholarship to 32 students of various self-financing disciplines.

DBT Programmes

Our college has achieved a milestone victory in getting support from the Ministry of Science and Technology, India, for developing infrastructure for academics and laboratory activities. The Department of Biotechnology (DBT), New Delhi has sanctioned the amount of Rs. 1.23 Crore under Star College Scheme for a period of 3 years from 2020 onwards for strengthening 6 UG Science Departments of our college viz., Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Mathematics & Computer Science, Botany & Biotechnology and Biochemistry.

The DBT has released the first installment amount of Rs. 81 lakhs for the financial year 2020-2021 under four different Heads such as Non-recurring Grant [Rs.10.00 lakhs per department]for purchasing the equipments,Recurring Grant [Rs. 3.00lakhs per department] 60% for procuring consumables [Apparatus, chemicals, software, slides, models, specimens and charts] and 40% for organizing various programmes, Travel Grant [Rs.2.00 lakhs] for Mentoring, Monitoring and Site visit and Contingency Grant [Rs. 1.00 lakh] for purchasing books/Journals and other expenses under this scheme.

- A Training Programme to the Government Higher Secondary School teachers of Virudhunagar District under Outreach Programme of the Star College Scheme, as per the revised syllabus of Tamilnadu Government, was conducted from15.12.2020 to 28.12.2020. Theywere trained on the efficient handling of theory and practical classes. Around 450 PG Assistant teachers from 98 Government Higher Secondary Schools in Virudhunagar District were highly benefitted under this scheme.
- College Managing Board donated 7 experimental set up to the Government Boys and Girls schools of Pandalkudi for the benefit of rural school students. The Faculty from the Department of Physics visited the schools and trained the teachers on the proper usage of the apparatus.
- On 23.11.2021, the Advisory Committee meeting was held through virtual platform with Dr. Garima Gupta, Scientist –‘E’, Programme Officer of Star College Scheme and Dr.MeenakshiMunshi, Scientist G, Advisor, Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, New Delhi , the Subject Experts, Dr.G.C.Abraham, Vice Principal, Associate Professor & Head, PG Department of Botany,The American College, Madurai and Dr.C.Ravidhas, Associate Professor &Head, PG & Research Department of Physics, Bishop Heber College,

Tiruchirappalli. All the Heads of the Science Departments had actively presented their slides with the planned activities.

- As per the instructions given by the Programme Officer and Advisor of DBT, Mentors Programme was conducted through online mode by each department for enhancing the teaching learning experience of the faculty and the students in the month of January 2021.
- A team of faculty visited PSGR Krishnammal College for Women, Coimbatore on 18.02.2021 as per the suggestions given by the Subject experts in the Advisory Committee Meeting, to be enlightened on effective implementation of this scheme in our college as PSGR College is being one of the best beneficiaries under this scheme in Tamilnadu.
- In accordance with the increased infrastructure facilities under this scheme, the contents of the syllabus were updated and a new dimension was added to the practical classes with the purchased equipments, software and books. The changes made in theory and practical parts were approved in the Board of Studies Meeting and Academic Council Meeting held on 19.2.2021 and 02.03.2021 respectively.
- Faculty members and students of Science Departments actively participated in Online Scientific Talk Organised by National Institute of Animal Biotechnology, Bangalore under Science Setu Programme as per the instructions of Department of Bio-Technology.
- To augment the research caliber of the students, they were involved in doing research projects in various innovative topics. 101 Research Projects were successfully carried out by the students.
- Seminars, Workshops, Conferences, Mentors Meetings, Inter Departmental Competitions were conducted and significant Days and weeks such as National Science Day, National Periodic Table Day Energy conservation week, Wild life Week, Kidney Day, National Forest Day, Ramanujan's Birth Day, etc were observed.
- 25 Faculty Development Programmes were organized. Under this DBT scheme, a large group of students, faculty, laboratory attendants, school teachers and the public were benefitted.

Physical Education

- Department of Physical Education organized physical fitness programme in the college campus from 08.10.2020 to 30.11.2020. Twenty sports students were engaged

in this physical fitness programme to reduce stress, prevent weight gain, and boost immune system.

- Department of Physical Education launched a special centre “VVVC UNIFORMED SERVICES COACHING CENTRE” where students aspiring to become police officers or intending to serve our nation can enroll themselves. The Placement Cell plays a crucial role in locating job opportunities for Under Graduates and Post Graduates by keeping in touch with reputed firms and industrial establishments. It works round the year to facilitate contacts between companies and graduates. The number of students placed through the campus interviews is continuously rising. On invitation, many reputed industries visit our college to conduct interviews.

Our college has been successful in maintaining our high placement statistics over the years even during the pandemic period. The outgoing students are well trained throughout the academic year in mental ability, interview techniques, soft skills and communication skills to make them employable graduates. The placement cell of our college is keen on providing job opportunities to students by making them attend various Job Fairs conducted at our college and other places by leading companies.

National Service Scheme

National Service Scheme of the College involves the student community to render social service to the rural community. The four units 183, 184, 223, 233 developed a sense of selfless service among the student volunteers and raised awareness on Covid-19, Road safety, Suffrage, polio drops and communal harmony. Totally 415 NSS volunteers promoted awareness among the people of their area through pamphlets and posters.

Pamphlets and Digital Posters were shared among the Volunteers through whatsapp group and other social media.
