Placement Cell

The Placement Cell of our college plays a crucial role in locating job opportunities for Under Graduates and Post Graduates passing out from the college by keeping in touch with reputed firms and industrial establishments. It works round the year to facilitate contacts between companies and graduates. The number of students placed through the campus interviews is continuously rising. On invitation, many reputed companies visit our college to conduct interviews.

- Our college has been successful in maintaining high placement statistics over the years even during the pandemic period. The outgoing students are well trained throughout the academic year in mental ability, interview techniques, soft skills and communication skills to make them employable graduates. The placement cell of our college is keen on providing job opportunities available through various Job Fairs conducted at our college and other places by leading companies.
