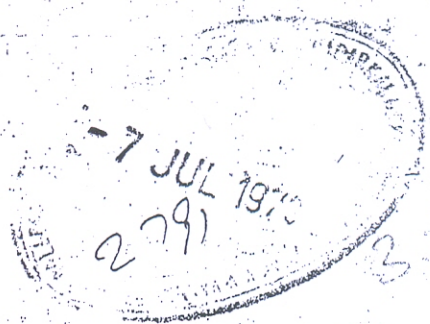

I am by direction to inform you that provisional temporary affiliation

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION TO BE FULFILLED BY THE COLLEGES:

- Under any circumstances, no additional staff should be permitted to be appointed by the Government or by the aided managements for the year 1979-80 as a result of granting affiliation for the year 1979-80 either under the major subjects or under Part I or Part II or under ancillary or optional subjects.

The first year of the degree course or post-graduate degree course for which affiliations are granted, new appointment of Super-graduate Professor or Post-graduate Professor as the case in 1979-80 need not be made.

Whatever appointment of additional staff is needed in a college for 1979-80, such appointment should be done by the management only from out of the list of surplus staff maintained by the Director of Collegiate Education. The teachers so transferred from one college to another shall be entitled to the service benefits to which they will be eligible if they continued in their present college.


4. Every college with more than 200 students strength shall be required to have a C.S.S, Co-Ordinator who will be one of the members of the staff of the college having spare workload so as to devote twelve hours towards C.S.S.works.
5. Colleges selected under College Complex Programme shall be required to implement the programme and for this purpose each college will be required to provide for such work for not less than 20 hours work and hours spent by the teaching staff for the college complex programme shall be reckoned for purposes of computation of workload.
6. The appointment of additional staff needed for the college should be got approved by the managements of the private colleges both by the University and the Director of Collegiate Education before making such appointments.

I am also to inform you that the appointments made without following the above procedures will not be recognised for purpose of assessment of grant. Hence, the managements of colleges are requested strictly to adhere the procedures laid down for appointing teachers in the college without fail.

I am further by direction to inform you that the additional endowment required for starting new degree/post-graduate courses should be provided in cash immediately.

Kindly acknowledge receipt and send a report about the admissions made and a report on the fulfilment of conditions of affiliation.
